Let's look back over some of the things we learnt about..




As a quick recap, you could go on Google Earth to find Teshie and explore!

We looked at African silhouette art and the impact of having a dark shadow on a bright sunset background.










We've looked at the different climates / weathers in Teshie and Herne bay. Using your chart from earlier in the term see what you can remember..
