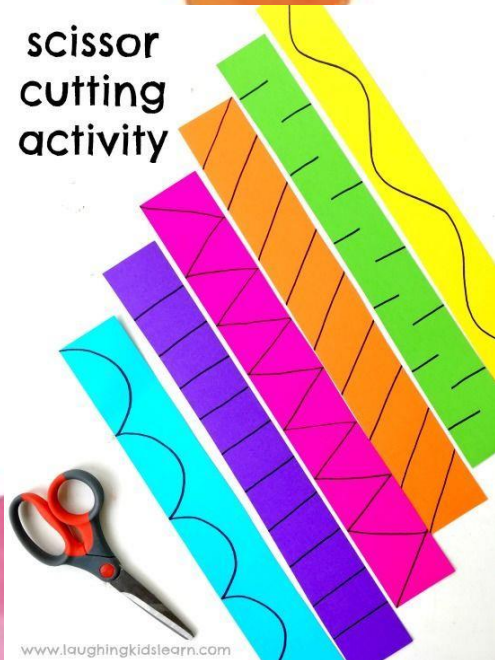


Fine Motor Ideas

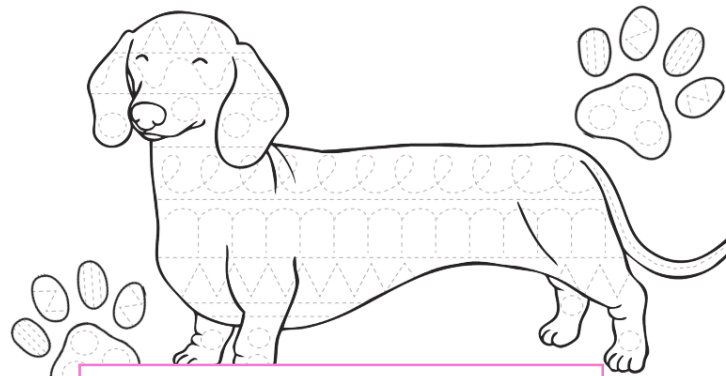

Here are some ideas for fine motor activities this week:

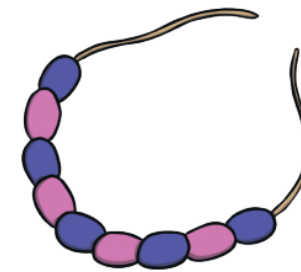

Complete a pattern tracing activity

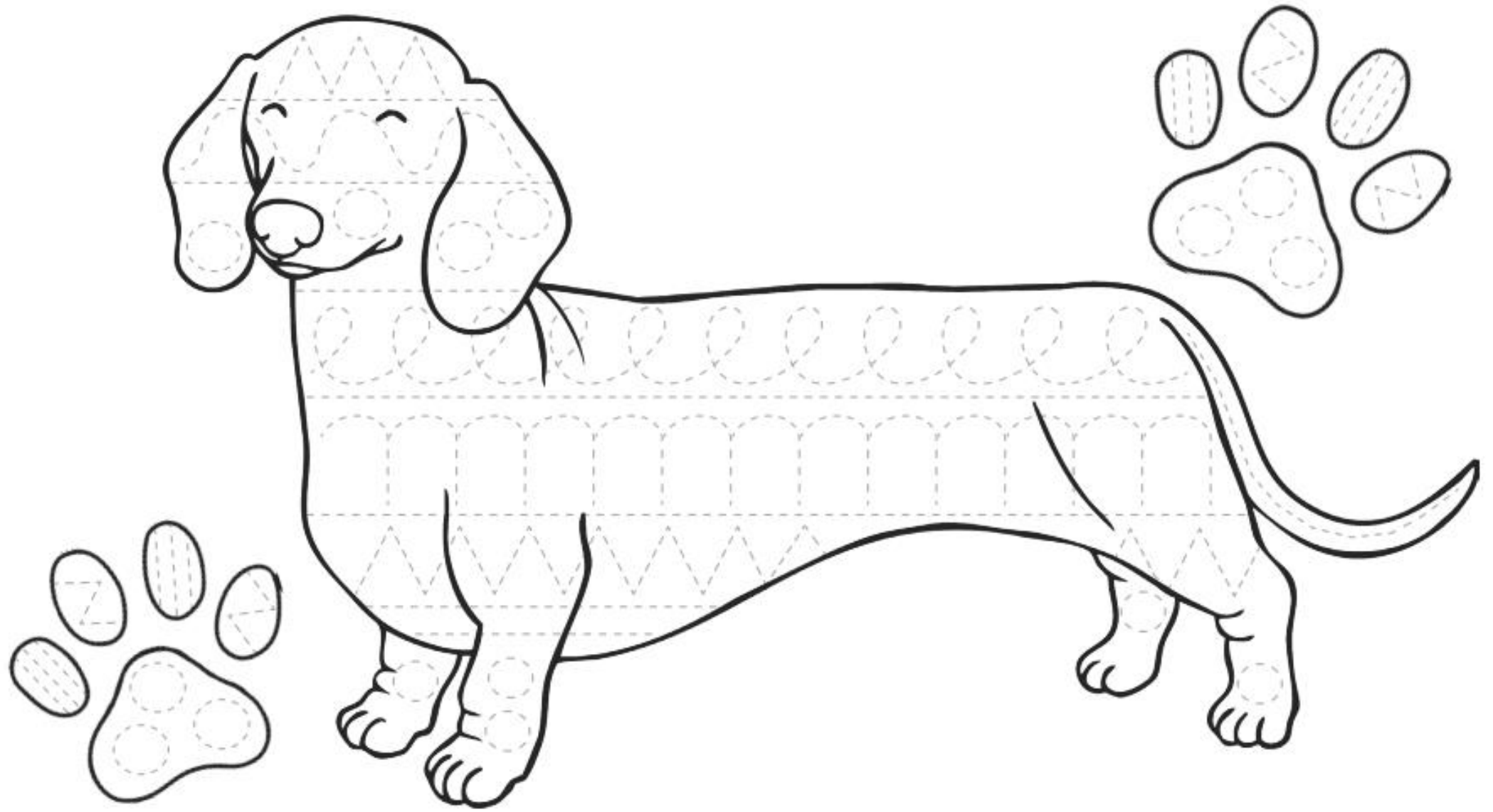


How many beads can you
