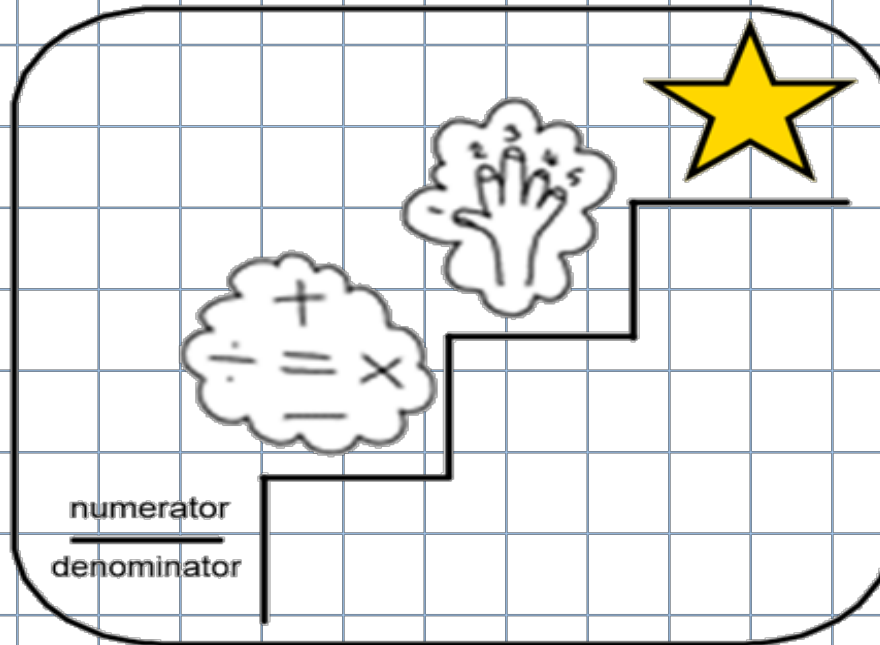


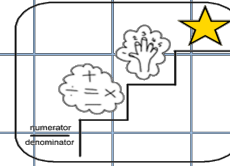

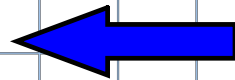

Numerator

The numerator is how many parts you are looking at/colouring

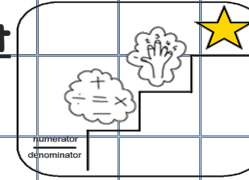
Denominator

The denominator is how many parts there are all together

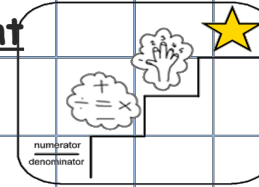

James collected cards but chose to swap half of them. If he had 22 cards, how many did he swap?

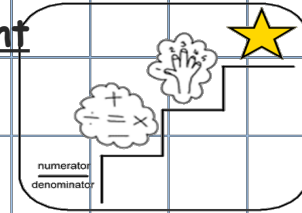


Fatima has 12 sweets. She shares her sweets and gives $\frac{1}{2}$ to her friend. How many sweets do they have each?

 $\frac{1}{4}$ of them have a bee on them. How many flowers are covered in bees?

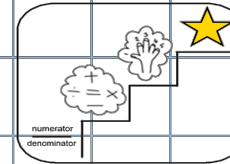


There are 8 fruits in the bowl.
