

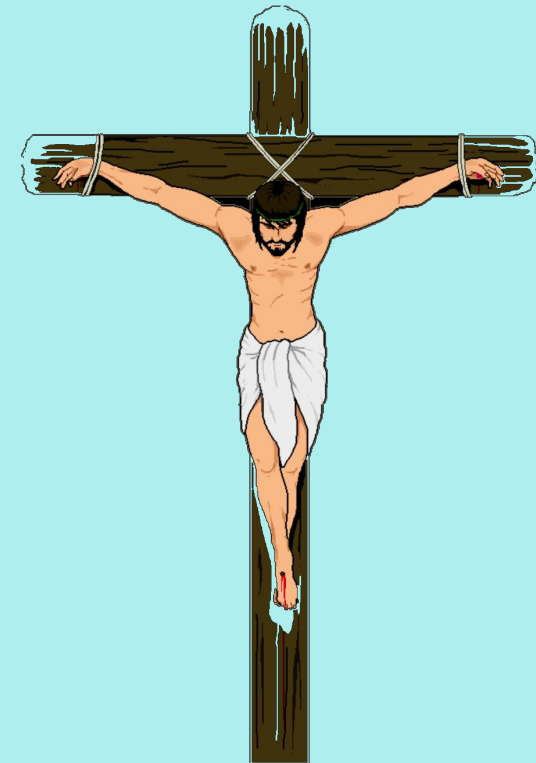


LQ: How is God, Incarnation, Gospel and Salvation part of the 'Big Story' of the Bible?

Easter is a time when Christians think about how Jesus died and came back to life to save them. This can be called **SALVATION**.

Jesus' death and resurrection effected the rescue/salvation of humans. He opened the way back to God. Christians believe that through Jesus, sin is dealt with, forgiveness offered, and the relationship between God and humans is restored.

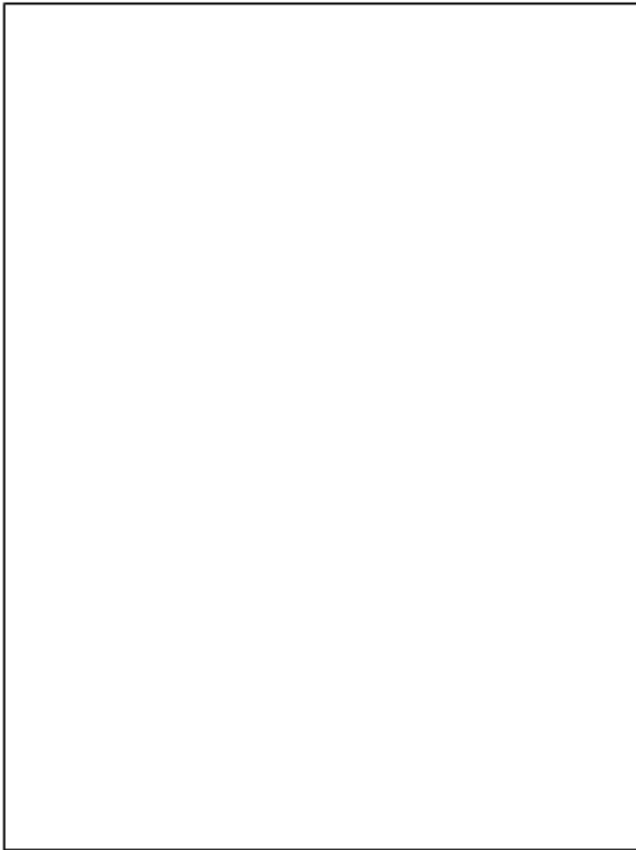
