


#### Adding the suffix: 'ment' and 'ness' to root words


A suffix is an ending to a word.

Suffixes are added on to the end of a root word (the main part of the word).

Last term, we learnt about the suffixes ed, ing, er, est and y.

We are going to be learning about the suffixes: ment and ness this week.

## Adding -ment and -ness as suffixes



enjoyment

movement

The suffix -ness can be added to a root word root word

Adding -ness as a suffix

happy sadness happiness

sad

When a suffix begins with a consonant, it is usually just added on!

Sometimes you may have to remember - if it ends in a y- use an i.

happy — happiness


