



This week we are learning about **homophones**.

**What are homophones?**

**Homophones are words that sound the same but have different meanings.**

Some homophones are **pronounced the same way and spelt the same way** but have different meanings, for example:

**rose (the flower) and rose (past tense of the verb to rise)**

Some homophones are **pronounced the same way but are spelled differently** and have different meanings. For example:

**wait (the verb) and weight (how heavy something is)**


