


What does a comma do? Where do we use them?

A comma tells a reader to take a short pause when they are reading, but not as long as a full stop.

We put commas in lists between nouns and adjectives.





I would like some games, books and new clothes for my birthday.

A comma has been used to separate words in a list (games, books)

Before the last word in the list use the word 'and' instead of a comma.

The words in a list do not always have to be nouns. They can also be adjectives.

The ball was red, small and bouncy.
