



- 4. What would you do to welcome Jesus to your house?








ZACCHAEUS climbs a tree

One day Jesus was coming to town and everyone went to see him. Zacchaeus was too small to see over the crowd and no one would let him through.




He quickly ran ahead and climbed up a tree. He waited for Jesus to go past. Now he could see Jesus.

- Talk about how things can break and need to be mended. As well as things breaking, sometimes friendships can also be 'broken'. If we remove a piece of the Jenga from the tower the building will weaken but if the blocks are in the correct order the building will be strong and stable.
- Our friendship with Jesus is similar to the blocks in the Jenga.
- We all break our friendship with Jesus if we do things we shouldn't. but when we ask for forgiveness our friendship with Him is mended.
- Zacchaeus' relationship with the people he had cheated had been broken, but Jesus mended the broken relationship by showing Zacchaeus that God loved him.







Helicopter prayers


Zacchaeus climbed a sycamore tree to see Jesus. The sycamore produces helicopter-like seeds.

You will need:


- Helicopter shape as pictured but much larger.

What to do:

- Bend one part of the tail forward and the other back.
- Attach a paper clip to the nose.
- Drop the helicopter and watch it spin!







Zacchaeus In A Tree Acrobat

You will need:

White & Green card, pipe cleaner, 2 bendy straws, Sellotape, glue stick, scissors, pencil, felt pens, ruler.






1. Draw a rectangle 8cm x 3cm.



2. Draw Zacchaeus in the rectangle, but don't draw any arms on him.



Fold the card in half & cut around Zacchaeus. You will end up with a front & back of Zacchaeus.




Draw the back of Zacchaeus.



Colour in Zacchaeus. Colour the coat the same colour as the pipe cleaner.



6. Sellotape the pipe cleaner to the back of Zacchaeus, where his arms would be.



Cover the other side of Zacchaeus in glue & press the two pieces of card firmly together.



8. Bend the pipe cleaner above the head of Zacchaeus & rest a pencil on top.



9. Twirl the pipe cleaner arms around the pencil.




10. To make the tree trunk, bend 2 straws & push one of the straws into the other. Sellotape to keep in place.



11. Gently take Zacchaeus off the pencil & thread him onto the middle of the straw.



12. On the green card draw the top of a tree.



13. Fold the card in half & cut around shape, you will end up two trees.



14. Sellotape the tops of the trees to either side of the straws.



Hold a straw in each hand and flick forward, Zacchaeus will spin around the 'tree trunk' like an acrobat!

Climb a tree

Zacchaeus climbed a tree to see Jesus. Ask your parents for permission to climb a tree, and ask them to watch you while you climb. Be careful!

Share

After Jesus came to his house, Zacchaeus wanted to share half of everything he had with poor people. The challenge for you this week is to share half of your sweets with your family!





A minute game - pennies

You will need:

- Plenty of pennies (at least 30)
- A minute timer watch/phone

How to play:

- Each player is given one minute to make a pile as high as possible with the pennies.
- The player can only use one hand and must put the other hand behind their back.



Sock challenge!

You will need:

- 'Post-it' notes
- Felt pen
- A sock rolled into a ball

How to play:

- Write Zacchaeus' name putting one letter on each of the 'Postit' notes.
- Place the letters on a door but not in order.
- Each player takes it in turns to throw the sock at the papers to spell Zacchaeus' name.
- Count how many times each player has thrown the sock.
- The winner is the player who successfully spells Zacchaeus' name by throwing the sock the least number of times.



Taxman Zac of Jericho (not a guy you'd like to know) Hearing Jesus was in town, off to Him he'd go! Taxman Zac, was rather small, couldn't see Jesus, not at all, thought, 'I'll climb a tree! How cool! Really mustn't fall'

Jesus walked, with crowd so near, by Zacs tree, then pausing there, said 'Hey Zac, now come down here; time to eat and share.' Jesus ate at Zacs, no shame, (He wasn't here to judge and blame), 'Life to the Max' Jesus explained - Zac wouldn't be the same.

Jesus, Saviour, praising You, changing lives - You make them new. Jesus, Saviour, thanking You, Lovin' what You (clap) do.
