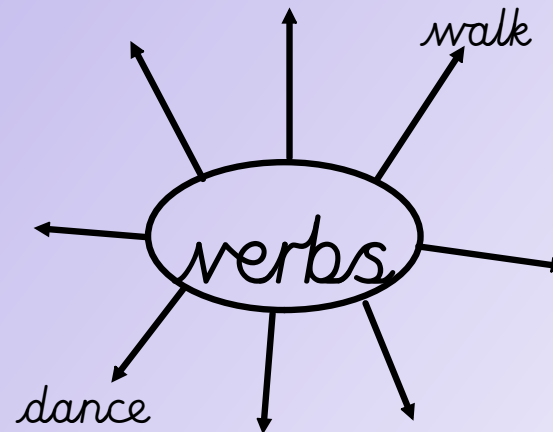
A verb is a doing/action word such as jump,
