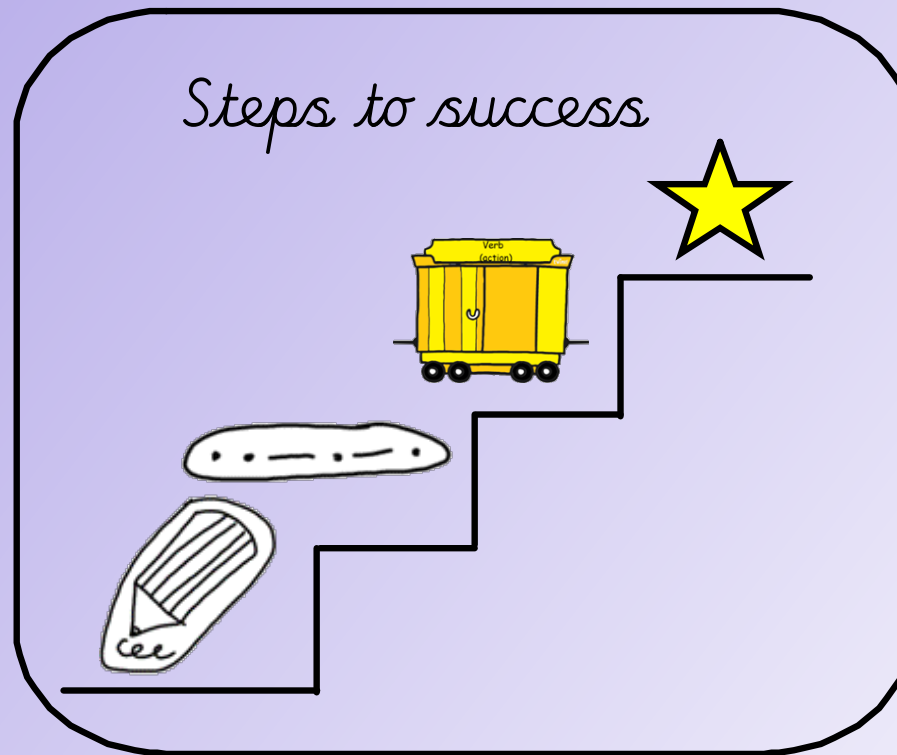
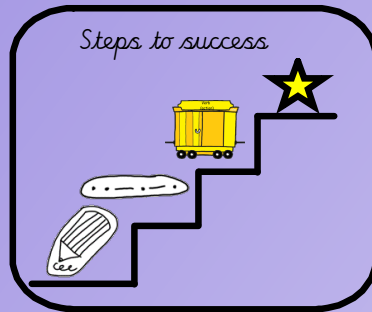

What do these symbols mean?



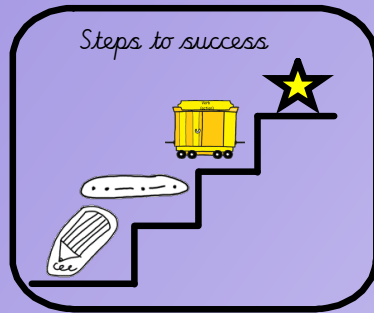
LO: To add -ing and -ed to verbs

What is a suffix?

A suffix is a group of letters that can be added to the end of a root word to slightly change its meaning.

Root word	Add -ed	Add -ing
enjoy	enjoyed	enjoying
watch	watched	watching
play	played	playing
