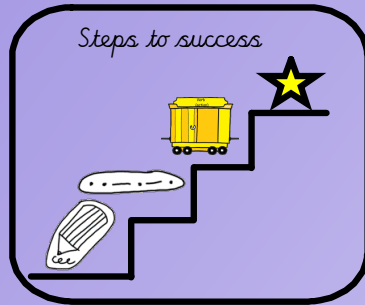
What do these symbols mean?

ask	asked	asking



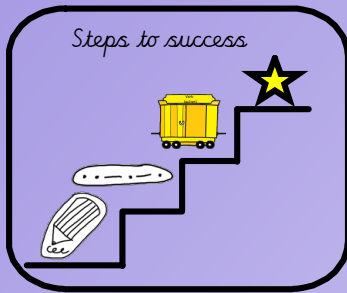
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What is a suffix?

We already know that a suffix is a group of letters that can be added to change the meaning of a word. For example it might change a word from being in the past tense to the present tense.

Sometimes we have to think extra carefully about how we change these words.
